

The Isles of Sarasota Hurricane Update:

Below are community updates on landscaping clean up and the status of the amenities.

Landscaping

Clean up: There are two crews onsite working on cleanup. One crew is focused on tree and stump removal and filling in the holes with soil. Sod will be installed over these areas. The second crew is focusing on cleaning up debris around the homes, and re-staking smaller trees when possible. The crew will be removing the trees that cannot be re-staked.

Irrigation: The irrigation system was shut off prior to hurricane Ian. The system has been turned on. The irrigation team will be inspecting the areas where trees were uprooted. Regular property inspection has resumed. If you see an irrigation issue please report it on the portal, www.hoa.brightview.com.

Enhancements: All enhancements have been put on hold. The scheduled October enhancement has been postponed until early November. This will be heavily influenced by the availability of plants. All shrub and plant damage due to the hurricane must be put on the BrightView Portal, www.hoa.brightview.com.

Driveway Pavers: Please note, repairs and preplacement of driveway pavers are the responsible of each homeowner.

Lifted Sidewalks: Sidewalks are the responsibility of Sarasota County. If there is a lifted section please notify either Sarasota County at 941-861-5000 or The Isles management office at 941-922-1298.

Amenities

Tennis: The tennis courts are closed and will remain closed until further notice. FOB access to the courts has been shut off. Due to the high winds and rain, the courts require a lot of service work to get them back to a condition which is safe and playable. Work includes hanging and washing the windscreens, hard raking the playing surface, installation of Har Tru, and repairs to the nets. This work requires time to complete, please be patient. The goal is to get the court open as soon as possible.

Pool: The pool has been cleaned, furniture has been set up and the pool is open.

Basketball & Pickleball: The multipurpose court is open for play. The windscreen will be rehung starting tomorrow.
