Bleeding Heart Vine

Botanical Name: Clerodendrum thomsoniae

Comments: Sun to shade; blooms on and off most of the year. Tendrils will attach to anything near.



Carolina Jasmine

Botanical Name: Gelsemium sempervirens

Comments: Slightly fragrant vine with yellow trumpet flowers January through spring.

Needs trellis or lattice for support.



Asiatic Jasmine or Jasmine Minima

Botanical Name: Trachelospermum asiaticum 'Minima'

Comments: Hardy, small leaf groundcover for sun or shade; better behaved than its cousin, Confederate Jasmine. Rarely flowers but adds a nice texture to the garden.



Confederate Jasmine

Botanical Name: Trachelospermum jasminoides

Comments: Fast growing vine with fragrant star-shaped flowers in the spring. Used as a groundcover in front of the clubhouse in the Isles. Grows willingly up structures as well, but needs regular maintenance to keep within bounds.
